 I will not threaten or abuse doctors and other surgery staff (this includes swearing) I will not threaten or abuse other patients (this includes swearing) I will not damage any property or write graffiti in and around the Health Centre I will not act in a manner that causes or is likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress to Doctors, surgery staff and other patients. I will notify the surgery if I am not able to attend an appointment I will not shout or abuse the surgery staff if there are no appointments available. I will not post any slanderous or defamatory remarks on social media i.e. Facebook / Twitter/Google etc. I will not smoke, use illicit drugs or drink alcohol on the premises.
BREACH OF THIS CONTRACT:
If Ido anything that I have agreed not to do under this contract with the practice, I can expect to be:
 Removed from the above doctors list Reported to the police with a view to charges being brought against me. Considered by the Health Board for listing under the Violent Patients regulations that could mean that I will be allocated to a surgery/primary care scheme at which a Doctor will only see me when police attend.
